Who can get a vaccine?

- Individuals 18 and older

What to expect?

- You must commit to getting a 2nd vaccine in four weeks on Wednesday, March 20, 2021
- Bring a driver and/or Navajo interpreter if needed, a black pen to complete forms, and valid identification to verify age and residence
- 15-30 minute observation following vaccination
- Possible long wait times. Please be mindful of your elders needs and be sure to bring snacks and drinks.
- Make sure your chart is updated and on file by calling Patient Registration: (928) 697-5380

You should not get a COVID-19 vaccine if you:

- Have had a known COVID-19 exposure, currently quarantined or received Monoclonal Antibodies
- Have symptoms of COVID-19, including a cough, fever, shortness of breath, or loss of taste or smell
- Have a pending COVID-19 test
- Had any other vaccine in the past 14 days
